

The University of Florida College of Medicine, Gainesville, Florida, is seeking a Chair for the Department of Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation. The state-of-the-art University of Florida Orthopaedics and Sports Medicine Institute, which opened in 2005, is located adjacent to an ambulatory center. The Institute was established under one roof to consolidate clinical care and research activities. The College of Medicine's clinical partner is Shands at UF.

The Department provides a comprehensive range of clinical services. There are 10 divisions with 21 FT faculty, 5 fellows and 20 residents. In addition to the clinical programs, the Department's research is strong, ranking 13th in NIH grants.

The successful candidate must demonstrate management experience to direct the clinical activities, research and teaching. Candidates should also have skills in further developing new services and supporting excellent patient care and nationally recognized research. Leading candidates will have demonstrated successful collaboration with hospital and school of medicine leadership. Experience in recruitment of faculty is also important. Eligible candidates must be board certified in orthopaedic surgery and have the academic credentials for appointment to the faculty of the University of Florida at the professor level.
